Emergency Weather Cancellation Plan
(PLEASE KEEP TOP HALF OF SHEET)**

Weather or mechanical breakdowns sometimes require early or emergency dismissal **during** the school day. District-wide emergency dismissals are announced on the television and radio stations listed below.

This Emergency Weather Cancellation Plan addresses those times when there is not an early dismissal and the District has not cancelled all after-school programs, but weather conditions are worsening.

Programs offered by the Out-of-school learning programs may announce cancellation of after-school programs (independent of a District decision) to assure safety of students, staff, and volunteers in its programs at the following schools: John Marshall, Hawthorn Hills, Lincoln, Stettin, Thomas Jefferson, Grant, GD Jones and Riverview. This decision will be announced by **1:00 PM** on television and radio stations listed below and by phone and/or e-mail via School Messenger. (This may precede a District-wide decision.)

If after-school programs must be cancelled, we would like to know that you have made plans for your child(ren). Please complete the form below and return it to your out-of-school Enrichment Coordinator. Discuss the plan with your child/children. It is difficult for students to telephone for instructions at these times, so we will keep a copy of your after-school plan on file. *Please plan ahead to assure the safety of your child and inform us of any changes in this plan. It is the responsibility of parents to be attentive to cancellations and to act accordingly to your child's plan in the event of a cancellation. Children must be picked up promptly at the close of the regular school day if not designated to walk home or ride the bus.*

Dear Parents or Guardians:

Beginning in December your child has the opportunity to participate in an outdoor activity called Nordic Bumps For Kids (offered in partnership with Knicker Nordic Development Group, a Not-for-Profit Organization). Bumps for Kids aspire to change the culture on how our youth play during the winter at school. By providing easy to use small skis, students gain new skills and exercise in a healthy outdoor activity which ultimately may transition into a lifelong pursuit. Knicker Nordic has a passion and commitment to extending these opportunities to young children in our community.

This opportunity has been offered previously to intermediate grade students after-school at Stettin, Riverview, Jefferson, Grant and Hawthorn Hills; and during recess at South Mountain. This year the program is expanding to 3 more schools. Each school will have twenty pairs of skis available. No poles will be used in this activity.

Similar programs are being developed throughout the state. While this activity is playful it develops coordination, strength, flexibility, and cardiovascular fitness. Additionally important is the introduction of lifelong skills and habits.

Riverview will be offering this to 3-5 grades during G2M after school. In order for your child to participate in Nordic Bumps for Kids, we must have a signed Permission Slip and a Waiver and Release of Claims by January 7, 2018.
